WHEREAS, Chef Mourad Lahlou opened Aziza in San Francisco's Richmond District in 2001 and has recently celebrated its 10th anniversary in the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Aziza contributes to the culinary diversity of our city with a fine dining approach to traditional Moroccan cuisine; and,

WHEREAS, Chef Lahlou's modern and sophisticated interpretations masterfully combine authentic Moroccan flavors with fresh and local ingredients; and

WHEREAS, Aziza supports local sustainable agriculture by purchasing their materials directly from local farms, ranches, and orchards who are committed to sound and wholesome habits; and

WHEREAS, In 2008, Chef Lahlou was named a "Rising Star Chef" by StarChefs; and WHEREAS, In 2009, Chef Lahlou won Iron Chef America by the biggest margin in the show's history; and

WHEREAS, In 2010, Aziza became the first Moroccan restaurant to receive a Michelin Star; and

WHEREAS, Aziza has since received a Michelin Star for three years in a row; and WHEREAS, Recognizing its record consistency and sustained excellence, Zagat has named Aziza one of its top ten Bay Area restaurants of the decade; and

WHEREAS, Chef Lahlou, a true Moroccan-American pioneer, has released a new cookbook, *Mourad: New Morrocan*, to document and share his acclaimed recipes with an international audience; and
