WHEREAS, WritersCorps staff and students were invited to the White House twice
 last fiscal year, first to receive the award from First Lady Michelle Obama in a special
 ceremony, and subsequently to participate in a national poetry workshop and performance
 event; and
 WHEREAS, WritersCorps publications have received the New York Public Library's

23 Best of Teen Books award and was featured in the New York Times Review of Books; and

24 WHEREAS, WritersCorps has received this grant award from the National Endowment
