[Recommending a Russian Language Multiple-Offender Driving Under the Influence Program]

Resolution recommending the National Council on Alcoholism and Other Drug

Addictions (NCADA) be licensed to offer a Russian language multiple-offender driving

under the influence (DUI) program in the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, The California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs' (ADP) Office of Criminal Justice Collaboration administers the Driving Under the Influence (DUI) Program through its DUI Programs Branch; and,

WHEREAS, The DUI Programs Branch licenses and monitors all DUI programs statewide, establishes regulations, approves participant fees and fee schedules, and provides information and technical assistance; and,

WHEREAS, The objectives of the DUI programs are to: (1) reduce the number of repeat DUI offenses by persons who complete a state-licensed program; and (2) provide participants an opportunity to address problems related to the use of alcohol and/or other drugs; and,

WHEREAS, ADP currently licenses 254 first-offender programs and 234 multiple-offender programs; and,

WHEREAS, Annually, more than 154,000 DUI offenders enroll in California's licensed programs; and,

WHEREAS, Although ADP is responsible for licensing all DUI programs statewide, the licensing process begins with the county Board of Supervisors, which works with the County Alcohol and Drug Program Administrator to recommend applicants to the State for licensure; and,

1	WHEREAS, Applicants must demonstrate administrative, fiscal, and operational
2	capabilities to operate a DUI program; provide program facilities that are clean, safe, and free
3	of alcohol or illicit drug use; and adhere to all applicable statutes and regulations; and,
4	WHEREAS, The National Council on Alcoholism and Other Drug Addictions (NCADA)
5	has successfully operated a first-offender program in San Francisco for more than 25 years
6	and,
7	WHEREAS, There currently exists no Russian language multiple-offender DUI program
8	in San Francisco; and
9	WHEREAS, NCADA is able to meet the capabilities required by ADP to offer a
10	multiple-offender DUI program in San Francisco and has the language capacity to offer a
11	multiple-offender DUI program in Russian; now, therefore, be it
12	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors recommends that the National Council on
13	Alcoholism and Other Drug Addictions (NCADA) be licensed to offer a Russian language
14	multiple-offender Driving Under the Influence (DUI) program in San Francisco.
