Conditions: (1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 12 noon – 2:00 am daily. (2) The front door(s) shall be kept closed after 7:00 p.m. while the privileges of the license area being

exercised, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. (3) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s) as defined on the ABC-257. (4) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited. (5) Petitioner shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the Department. (6) No person under the age of 21 years of age shall enter or remain in this public premises. (7) The petitioner shall utilize electronic surveillance and recording equipment that is able to view inside and outside the premises and that is actively maintained and recorded. This electronic surveillance shall be in place during operating hours. Said electronic recording shall be kept up to (72) hours and shall be made available to the Department or Police Department upon demand.
