

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



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Whole Foods Market's Application - A Protest

My name is Edward Buzinky, and I have been a resident of San Francisco's Noe Valley for over twenty years. I recently noted the display of the ABC application to sell hard liquor on Whole Foods' glass façade, and hereby protest, on the basis of the public welfare, such application to sell hard liquor in addition to wine.

1. The health, vitality and vibrancy of Noe Valley's 24th Street commercial district is at stake.

Whole Foods has been very aggressive in stocking and selling popular foods and goods the surrounding (and much smaller) merchants stock and sell. Here are a few examples of the negative consequences this behavior has wrought:

Whole Foods has expanded its offerings of ready-to-eat meals, and now it is my understanding that the Joe's 24th Street Cafe (3853 24th Street) and the Noe Valley Deli (4007 24th Street) are "for sale;"

Whole Foods offers a wide variety of cheeses, and the 24th St. Cheese Co. (3893)

24th Street) has seen its business decline;

· Whole Foods expands its cosmetics offerings, and it is my understanding Common Scents (3920 24th Street) is sold by its two owners for only shelving and inventory; and

Whole Foods sells flowers, and the French Tulip (3903 24th Street) closes shop.

Where will this end? Will it end with a wildly-profitable Whole Foods surrounded by boarded-up store fronts? The health, vitality and vibrancy of 24th Street is at stake. This is our community; this is our public welfare.

I suggest the Department talk with merchants and hear their concerns about Whole Foods' attempt to corner the market on everything consumable, popular and for sale on 24th. I've asked and heard them. I've known these wonderful merchants for a generation! Enough is enough! Whole Foods knowingly leased a small store with limited parking, and I'm sure the store is wildly profitable for them and has been from the start. On balance, they must forgo hard liquor.

In addition, there are many stores in Noe Valley, perhaps too many, that already sell hard liquor. We do not need another for all the reasons discussed herein.

2. Expanding to hard liquor further increases Whole Foods' existing threat to the Public Welfare.

Whole Foods has a small parking lot and it is packed, with cars in both directions on 24th Street jockeying for position, blocking traffic, encroaching the sidewalk, talking on cell phones, watching the parking attendants, hearing horns honking from behind and waiting for an open space. RECEIVED

I'm relatively nimble, and it's dangerous for me. Does the Department realize how many moms and babies and toddlers and carriages are out on 24th any given day? Many, many people walk the sidewalk in front of Whole Foods, and are forced, at risk to their safety and well-being, to weave between idling cars and distracted drivers encroaching the sidewalk.

This is a tragedy waiting to happen.

In addition, on Sunday, July 24th, I witnessed the fire chief's red SUV, siren blasting, stopped cold in front of Whole Foods due to the lack of a path resulting from auto congestion both ways. The street stops both ways, many times a day - a result of cars attempting to access the Whole Foods' parking lot.

Should SF Fire, Rescue, and Police find a route other than 24th Street to respond to emergencies?

Or should SF Fire, Rescue and Police just have to accept periodic and unpredictable delays in response time, and our citizens who require fire or medical attention or police protection just have to be more patient?

Obviously not, and I wouldn't want to stand idly by when the risks to public welfare are so obvious and demonstrable.

Selling hard liquor will only increase traffic to and around the store! These issues will only get worse.

The commercial, community, public and personal welfare is at risk.

l therefore oppose this application and pray for its denial.
