LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Changing the Official Sidewalk Width - Portion of Mason Street]

Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks" by adding thereto Section 1590 to change the official sidewalk width of Mason Street starting at the southwest corner of the intersection of Mason Street and Washington Street and continuing south 29.52 feet; making environmental findings and findings pursuant to the General Plan and Planning Code Section 101.1; requiring relocation, modification, or both of facilities affected by the sidewalk width change.

Existing Law

Board of Supervisors' Ordinance No. 1061 established the official sidewalk widths throughout San Francisco.

Amendments to Current Law

This legislation would amend Ordinance No. 1061 to change the official sidewalk width of Mason Street starting at the southwest corner of the intersection of Mason Street and Washington Street and continuing south 29.52 feet. The Ordinance would make environmental findings and findings of conformity with the General Plan and Planning Code Section 101.1. This legislation also requires that any necessary relocation, modification, or both of utility facilities shall be at the cost of the owner of the utility.
