3	Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type 40 on-sale beer license to
4	Mark E. Rennie for Bar Downtown, LLC., dba Craft, located at 440 Mission Street
5	(District 6), will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the
6	City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the
7	California Business and Professions Code, with conditions

9	WHEREAS, Mark E. Renne is seeking issuance of a Type 40 on-sale beer
10	license for Bar Downtown, LLC., dba Craft, located at 440 Mission Street; and,
11	WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
12	zoned; and,
13	WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license
14	application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it
15	RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
16	and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
17	Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 40
18	on-sale beer license to Mark E. Renne for Bar Downtown, LLC., dba Craft, located at
19	440 Mission Street, will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the
20	City and County of San Francisco.
21	Conditions: (1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be
22	from 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. daily, and from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. when the premises
23	is broadcasting (real time) the World Cup soccer and the Olympics. This privilege shall
24	be subject to advance written notice to the Department at least one (1) week prior to the
25	event. (2) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee

as defined on the ABC-257. (3) No person under the age of twenty-one (21) shall sell, furnish, or deliver alcoholic beverages. (4) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257. (5) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (6) Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday. (7) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences. (8) There shall be no off sale of alcoholic beverages in containers of less than 32 ounces. (9) All off sale alcoholic beverages shall be restricted to craft beers.
