1 [Setting the 2012 Budget and Legislative Analyst Services Audit Plan] 2 3 Motion directing the Budget and Legislative Analyst to conduct three performance 4 audits in 2012 and setting the priority as follows: 1) the Department of Public Health's 5 and Human Services Agency's management of professional services contracts; 2) City 6 departments' management and oversight of the former San Francisco Redevelopment 7 Agency's assets and functions; and 3) the Adult Probation and Sheriff's Departments' 8 implementation of Public Safety Realignment. 9 10 WHEREAS. It is the policy of the Board of Supervisors that each program of the City 11 and County of San Francisco be the subject of a performance audit at least once every eight 12 years; and 13 WHEREAS, The function of regular performance audits is to ensure that City 14 departments and agencies make prudent and efficient use of City resources and also 15 effectively perform the functions assigned to them by the Chart and applicable laws; now, 16 therefore, be it 17 MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst is hereby directed as a first priority to 18 conduct a performance audit of the Department of Public Health's and Human Services 19 Agency's management of professional services contracts, including how the Department determines the need for professional services, and measures and reports service levels and 20 21 changes: policies and procedures for contract performance and performance measurement: 22 and department-wide contracting policies and compliance; and, be it 23 FURTHER MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst is hereby directed as a 24 second priority to conduct a performance audit of the transfer of the former San Francisco 25 Redevelopment Agency's (SFRA) assets and functions to the City, including how SFRA staff, Supervisor Farrell

assets and functions are assigned to City departments; City departments' management and performance of development functions previously the responsibility of the SFRA; and City departments' management of assets previously the responsibility of the SFRA; and, be it FURTHER MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst is hereby directed as a third priority to conduct a performance audit of the Adult Probation and Sheriff Departments' implementation of Public Safety Realignment, including (a) increases in caseload and average jail population resulting from the transfer of certain offenders from the State to the County, (b) the Adult Probation and Sheriff's Departments' implementation of new programs to support the transfer of these offenders, including implementation schedules, program costs, performance measures, and outcomes; and (c) Adult Probation and Sheriff's Departments' staffing levels to support the transfer of these offenders.
