Resolution authorizing the Office of Treasurer-Tax Collector to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$190,000 from the Earned Assets Resource Network for Kindergarten to College Program Participant Incentive Funds.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco established the Kindergarten to College program in 2010 to provide college savings accounts for San Francisco Unified School District kindergarteners with an initial deposit of \$50; and

WHEREAS, participant incentives, such as matching deposits, and funds to encourage regular saving through direct deposit of funds, are integral components of Kindergarten to College; and

WHEREAS, The Earned Assets Resource Network has granted \$190,000 to provide incentives for participants to make deposits into their Kindergarten to College accounts; and
