



There is an over concentration of alcohol in this neighborhood already. While I am supportive of local businesses and a vibrant community, we have already had instances of so called "full service restaurants" morphing into loud unruly bars. Our community's experience has been that once there is an alcohol license more problems follow.

Quiet enjoyment of our homes and the quality of life of residents is negatively impacted by the bar scene on this street right now, and in particular on this block by an existing sports bar. In addition, this space has always been a retail shop and is not authorized as a restaurant under City Code. Many neighbors as close as 100 feet received no notification of the Alcohol License Application, but were only informed by viewing the posting on the premises. Also, this establishment is less than 500 feet away from an Elementary School and is almost adjacent to Allyne Park, where children play. This is a highly residential area with many children and families.

Similar businesses have met with local neighborhood and merchant associations. This applicant has made no attempt at such outreach and has failed to properly notice property owners and residents. Please deny this unnecessary and unwanted alcohol license.
