11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
12	Section 1. Findings. The Planning Department has determined that the actions		
13	contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act		
14	(California Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with		
15	the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein		
16	reference. This ordinance is consistent with the General Plan and Priority Policies of		
17	Section101.1(b)of the Planning Code for the reasons set forth in the Planning Commission		
18	Resolution No and the Board incorporates said Resolution herein by		
19	reference. A copy of said resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in

1	Section 2. The San Francisco Planning Code is hereby amended by adding Section		
2	187.2, to read as follows:		
3	(a) As used in this Section. "automotive service station" and "gasoline station" shall mean an		
4	establishment that sells and dispenses gasoline and other motor fuels and lubricating fluids directly		
5	into motor vehicles and which may, in addition, provide the types of services specified in Section		
6	223(f) and 223 (g) of this Code; provided that the limitation on automobile washing and polishing		
7	contained in Section 223(f)(6) shall not be interpreted as limitation on the addition of a mechanical		
8	car wash as provided in this Section 187.2.		
9	(b) As used in this Section, "mechanical car wash" shall mean an automotive was facility,		
10	including the use of any mechanical cleaning devices, the use of any mechanical conveyor blower		
11	device, or steam cleaning device, and may include washing and polishing performed by hand.		
12	(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, a mechanical car wash is permitted as		
13	a conditional use under Section 303 of this Code on the same premises as an automotive service		
14	station or gasoline station, existing on the effective date of this Ordinance, and located on Nineteenth		
15	Avenue, starting at Lincoln Way and continuing south on Nineteenth Avenue to the southerly portion		
16	of Nineteenth Avenue to the intersection with Junipero Serra Boulevard, continuing south along		
17	Junipero Serra Boulevard to the southern boundary of the City and County of San Francisco, and		
18	provided:		
19	(1) A vehicle storage and standing area is provided on the premises outside the washing		
20	facilities of sufficient size to accommodate at least one-quarter of the hourly capacity in vehicles of		
21	the facility;		
22	(2) Noise from the facility complies with Article 29 of the San Francisco Police Code and in		
23	no event shall noise from mechanical equipment exceed 65 dBA, as defined in Article 29, from 7:00		
24	am to 10:00 pm, or 60 dBA from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am, when measured at any location on adjoining		
25	residential property.		

1	(3) Automobile washing and drying occurs entirely within an enclosed building.		
2	(4) Water use and reclamation meets criteria established by the Zoning Administrator in		
3	consultation with staff from the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission.		
4	(5) A traffic study demonstrates that the operation will not cause a new significant impact on		
5	traffic on adjacent streets.		
6	(6) The facility is located on a lot equal to or greater than 12,000 square foot.		
7	Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the		
8	date of passage.		
9	Section 4. This section is uncodified. In enacting this Ordinance, the Board intends		
10	to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers,		
11	punctuation, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent part of the Planning Code		
12	that are explicitly shown in this legislation as additions, deletions, Board amendment		
13	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears		
14	under the official title of the legislation.
