6 WHEREAS, Ron Isola has been an institution at Archbishop Riordan High School for
7 more than five decades; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Isola graduated from the school in 1961, and six years later returned
9 to his alma matter to begin a distinguished career as a teacher and coach; and

10 WHEREAS, During his tenure at Archbishop Riordan High School, Mr. Isola served as
11 a coach, mentor, and exemplary role model to over 25,000 young men; and

12 WHEREAS, Under his leadership the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Program flourished,
13 participating in many Western Catholic Athletic League (WCAL) and Central Coast Section
14 (CCS) championships; and

15 WHEREAS, from 1978 through 1994, as varsity basketball coach Mr. Isola lead his
16 teams to seven WCAL Championships and five CCS Championships; and

17 WHEREAS, The Riordan Crusaders won every home game from 1983 until 1989 and
18 hold a league-record in WCAL play for their 44 game win streak; and

19 WHEREAS, Since 1973, Mr. Isola's Camp Crusader Summer Program has served the
20 Bay Area by providing summer fun and exercise for more than 12,000 children; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Isola's career has been distinguished by numerous awards and
22 accolades including the Archbishop Riordan Chaminade Award, as well as, induction into the
23 San Francisco Prep Hall of Fame and the Archbishop Riordan and Epiphany School Hall of
