Resolution celebrating the 75th anniversary of the Golden Gate Bridge and proclaiming May 27, 2012, to be "Golden Gate Bridge Day" in the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is pleased to join in celebrating milestones in the history of landmarks that illustrate our noble heritage and whose creation had a meaningful impact upon the lives of our citizens, and one such landmark is the Golden Gate Bridge – an exceptional example of engineering and a symbol of the human ingenuity that has prevailed since the founding of this great nation; and

WHEREAS, For the past 75 years, the Golden Gate Bridge has stood as an iconic symbol of life in the San Francisco Bay Area and is viewed as one of the greatest structures of the twentieth century, an architectural marvel in terms of its complex and unprecedented construction and its unique structural form; and

WHEREAS, This seamless stretch of elongated cables and steel beams represents the progressive vision of renowned bridge engineer Joseph Strauss, whose experience constructing other suspension bridges provided him with remarkable foresight in designing the longest suspension bridge of its day, which many said could not be built; and
