

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Koret Foundation Grant - \$25,000]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Arts Commission to retroactively accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$25,000 from the Koret Foundation for the ArtCare**
5 **Program.**

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7 WHEREAS, The 1969 Art Enrichment Ordinance was adopted so that up to two
8 percent of every San Francisco public works project budget be allocated to the commissioning
9 or acquisition of artwork for that site-specific project; and

10 WHEREAS, The Civic Art Collection now has 4,000 objects worth approximately
11 \$93,000,000; and

12 WHEREAS, The Civic Art Collection includes 19th century historic monuments, 40-
13 year-old contemporary sculptures in every medium, paintings, fiber art, murals, jewelry,
14 ceramics and ephemera, located throughout San Francisco and at SFO; and

15 WHEREAS, An inadequate amount of Capital Funds are allocated to the maintenance,
16 repair and restoration of the artworks that comprise the Civic Art Collection; and

17 WHEREAS, If these artworks are not maintained the City will permanently lose these
18 assets; and

19 WHEREAS, The Arts Commission launched ArtCare in spring 2010, a public-private
20 partnership to raise individual and philanthropic dollars to create a pool of funds for the
21 maintenance, repair and restoration of the aging Civic Art Collection; and

22 WHEREAS, The Arts Commission proposes to maximize use of available grant funds
23 on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore be
24 it

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1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
2 the grant budget; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors allows for retroactively
4 accepting and expending this awarded Koret Foundation grant to the Arts Commission, with a
5 grant cycle of 5/24/11-12/30/11; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Arts Commission's request, which has been funded
7 and involves no ASO amendments, be carried out in accordance with all grant requirements
8 and may be spent and reported upon accordingly.
