8 WHEREAS, The Director of Public Works has entered into an agreement dated
9 November 30, 2000 with the predecessor in interest of Stantec Architecture Inc for the design
10 of the Laguna Honda Hospital Replacement Program in an amount of not to exceed
11 \$2,400,352; and

12 WHEREAS, Resolutions 994-01, 579-03, 561-04, 667-05, 57-07, 358-08 and 240-10,
13 the Board of Supervisors authorized the Director to enter into amendments to the agreement
14 which when amended would not exceed \$50,799,281 and a term not to exceed December 21,
15 2012; and

16 WHEREAS, the Director has entered into a novation agreement with Stantec
17 Architecture Inc, in which it accepted the rights and responsibilities of the predecessor in
18 interest, and

19 WHEREAS, Section 9.118(b) of the Charter requires that all agreements in excess of
20 ten million dollars or amendments to said agreements in excess of \$500,000 be approved by
21 the Board of Supervisors; and

22 WHEREAS, the Director intends to increase the scope of services under said
23 agreement to extend construction administration services, augment architectural staff, and

1 provide redesign services and to increase the sum under said agreement from the amount of
2 \$50,799,281 to the amount of \$51,276,867; and

3 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Director of
4 Public Works to enter into further amendments to the November 30, 2000 agreement with
5 Stantec Architecture Inc., resulting in a contract amount not to exceed \$51,276,867.

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**Legislative Objectives**

- The proposed resolution would authorize the Director of Public Works to execute an amendment for Modification Nos. 18 and 19 to the Design Agreement between the Department of Public Works (DPW) and Stantec for the Laguna Honda Hospital (LHH) Replacement Program to increase the Design Agreement by \$3,180,958, from a not-to-exceed \$50,799,281 to a not-to-exceed \$53,980,239. The term of the agreement will remain unchanged from November 20, 2000 through December 31, 2012.

Key Points

- The proposed resolution would authorize the Director of Public Works to execute an amendment to the Design Agreement for Modification No. 18 in the amount of \$477,586 and Modification No. 19 in the amount of \$2,703,372 for a total of \$3,180,958.
- However, Modification No. 18 for \$477,586 was previously executed by DPW in January of 2012. The proposed resolution should therefore reflect only Modification No. 19 in the amount of \$2,703,372. The Budget and Legislative Analyst recommends amending the proposed resolution to reflect the correct existing not-to-exceed amount of \$51,276,867 instead of \$50,799,281 in order to account for the previously approved Modification No. 18 in the amount of \$477,586.
- The subject amendment to increase the Design Agreement by \$2,703,372 from \$51,276,867 to \$53,980,239 would fund increased design services costs for contractor design services costs associated with additional required repair work and additional construction administration, that was unforeseen, but resulted from the poor condition of the existing LHH facilities.

Fiscal Impact

- The proposed increase for Modification No. 19, in a not-to-exceed amount of \$2,703,372, would increase the existing Design Agreement's not-to-exceed amount from \$51,276,867 to a not-to-exceed amount of \$53,980,239, an increase of 5.3 percent.

Recommendations

- Amend the proposed resolution to increase the existing not-to-exceed amount of \$50,799,281, by \$477,586, to \$51,276,867.
- Approve the proposed resolution, as amended.

MANDATE STATEMENT/BACKGROUND**Mandate Statement**

In accordance with Charter Section 9.118, any contract (a) for more than \$10,000,000, (b) that extends for longer than ten years, or (c) with an amendment of more than \$500,000, is subject to Board of Supervisors approval.

Background

The Laguna Honda Hospital (LHH) Replacement Program is a \$584,946,602 project which provides for the demolition, construction, and renovation of a new LHH. The LHH Replacement Program includes construction of new hospital facilities to accommodate 780 beds, and renovation of existing buildings to be used primarily for administrative and support staff. According to Mr. John Thomas of DPH, Program Manager for the LHH Replacement Program, all major work associated with the Replacement Program (including design services and construction work) will be completed by December, 2012, with final demolition of two wings of the original hospital facility in early 2013.

Following a competitive bid process in July of 2000, the Department of Public Works (DPW) entered into an agreement with Stantec, formerly Anshen & Allen /Stantec Architecture (a Joint Venture) and prior to that Anshen & Allen Architects/Gordon H. Chong & Partners.¹ Under this agreement, Stantec, provides design services throughout the planning, design, bid, construction and post construction phases of the LHH Replacement Program. The original agreement was for the period from November 20, 2000 through November 30, 2010 for an initial not-to-exceed amount of \$2,400,352. According to Mr. Thomas, the initial not-to-exceed amount was not intended to cover the entire design cost of the project. Rather, the original amount was intended only to cover conceptual design, with funding for future design tasks to be awarded through amendments to the original Design Agreement. Based on subsequent amendments, the Design Agreement is currently scheduled to expire on December 31, 2012.

Attachment I provided by Mr. Thomas, shows the original Design Agreement for \$2,400,352 and summarizes the prior 18 modifications, including seven modifications which were subject to Board of Supervisors approval. As shown in Attachment I with the proposed Modification No. 19, the subject Design Agreement's total not to exceed amount would be \$53,980,239.

¹ The original Design Agreement was awarded in 2000 by DPW to Anshen & Allen Architects/Gordon H. Chong & Partners (a Joint Venture). However, in 2007, Gordon H. Chong & Partners was acquired by Stantec Architecture, such that the Design Agreement was subsequently amended in 2007 to reflect the assignment from Anshen & Allen Architects/Gordon H. Chong & Partners (a Joint Venture) to Anshen & Allen Architects/Stantec Architecture (a Joint Venture). Then in November 2010 Stantec Acquired Anshen + Allen.

DETAILS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

The proposed resolution would authorize the Director of Public Works (DPW) to execute an amendment, consisting of Modification No. 18 and Modification No. 19, to the Design Agreement with Stantec for the LHH Replacement Program, in order to increase the Design Agreement by \$3,180,958 from a not-to-exceed \$50,799,281 to a not-to-exceed \$53,980,239. The term of the existing agreement will remain unchanged from November 20, 2000 through December 31, 2012.

Mr. Thomas advised that the subject amendment to increase the Design Agreement by \$3,180,958 would fund increased contractor design services costs associated with additional required repair work and additional construction administration, that was unforeseen, but resulted from the poor condition of the existing structures. In addition, Mr. Thomas explains that the poor condition of the existing LHH building has mandated extensive repairs which must be reviewed by OSHPD (Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development), which has also resulted in additional contractor design services costs.

FISCAL IMPACTS

As shown in Attachment I, the proposed resolution would authorize the Director of Public Works to execute an amendment to the Design Agreement for Modification No. 18 in the amount of \$477,586 and Modification No. 19 in the amount of \$2,703,372 for a total increase in the Design Agreement between the DPW and Stantec in the amount of \$3,180,958. However, Mr. Thomas advises that Modification 18 in the amount of \$477,586 was previously executed by DPW in January 2012. Modification 18 for \$477,586 is less than \$500,000, and in accordance City Charter Section 9.118(b), was not subject to Board of Supervisors approval.

Since only Modification No. 19 for an increased amount of \$2,703,372 needs approval of the Board of Supervisors, the proposed resolution should be amended to reflect the correct existing not-to-exceed amount of \$51,276,867 instead of \$50,799,281 in order to account for the previously approved Modification No. 18 in the amount of \$477,586.

Attachment II, provided by Mr. Thomas, identifies the types of design related work to be funded with the proposed increase of \$2,703,372 for Stantec and its subcontractors. The proposed increase for Modification No. 19, in a not-to-exceed amount of \$2,703,372, would increase the existing Design Agreement's not-to-exceed amount from \$51,276,867 to a not-to-exceed amount of \$53,980,239, an increase of 5.3 percent. The total proposed Design Agreement for \$53,980,239 represents 9.2 percent of the total budgeted \$584,946,602 LHH Replacement Program.

As shown in the Table below, the LHH Replacement Program budget remains at \$584,946,602, as previously approved by the Board of Supervisors. The total \$584,946,602 LHH Replacement Program budget is funded with (a) \$322,855,185 of General Obligation Bonds, (b) \$140,992,731 of Tobacco Settlement Revenue (c) \$120,000,000 of Certificates of Participation and (d) \$1,098,686 of grants from the U.S. Health Resources and Services Administration and

the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. As also shown in the Table below, as of May 24, 2012, a total of \$559,364,264 has been expended or encumbered on the LHH Replacement Program, leaving a remaining unexpended, unencumbered balance of \$25,582,338. The proposed Modification 19 to the Design Agreement for \$2,703,372 is included in the remaining costs as shown in the Table below.

In addition to the requested Modification 19 for \$2,703,372, Mr. Thomas stated that an additional amendment may be necessary in the future in order to extend the term of the existing Design Agreement or to provide additional funding, since there have been further delays as a result of additional necessary repairs to the LHH roof deck and floor slabs in the old kitchen and freezer areas. As noted above, the existing Design Agreement will expire December 31, 2012.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**City Lawsuit Against Stantec For Design Errors and Omissions**

According to Ms. Louise Simpson of the City Attorney's Office, in December of 2011, the City filed a lawsuit against Stantec for design errors and omissions committed on the Laguna Honda Replacement Project. Ms. Simpson advises that this lawsuit relates primarily to the design for construction of three new LHH buildings, which are now completed and occupied. Ms. Simpson further notes that the proposed Modification 19 to the Design Agreement with Stantec relates to the separate remodel of existing LHH buildings.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Amend the proposed resolution to increase the existing not-to-exceed amount of \$50,799,281, by \$477,586, to \$51,276,867.
2. Approve the proposed resolution, as amended.

MODIFICATION NO. 19 TO THE AGREEMENT

Between the City and County of San Francisco and
STANTEC ARCHITECTURE INC ("SAI")

The City and County of San Francisco and Stantec Architecture Inc have entered into an Agreement dated November 20, 2000. This Modification to the Agreement ("Modification No. 19") is dated March 5, 2012 in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, by and between the City and County of San Francisco (the "City"), a municipal corporation acting through its Department of Public Works ("Department") and Stantec Architecture Inc (the "Architect").

On or around December 12, 2011, the City and County of San Francisco filed suit against Stantec Architecture, Inc. and its predecessors ("Architect") to the Executive Architect Agreement for the Laguna Honda Hospital Replacement Program (SF Sup. Ct. Case No. CGC-11-516530), claiming damages arising from Architect's breach of contract and professional negligence and Architect's obligation to indemnify the City for related losses. Under Sections 3.3.2(6) and 4.1.5(6) of the Architect Agreement, Architect is not entitled to compensation for changes to the Contract Documents arising from Architect's errors, conflicts or omissions. In addition, under Section 1.3(c) of the Architect Agreement, Architect is to provide construction administration services through the actual completion of construction at no additional charge, where the construction was delayed beyond the scheduled completion date due to Architect's fault. The City disputes Architect's entitlement to some or all of the monies reflected in this Modification No. 19 to the Architect Agreement and reserves all of its rights against Architect, including but not limited to, its right to seek reimbursement or refund of any monies paid pursuant to this Modification or to recover any such monies as an item of loss or damage.

WHEREAS, the parties intend to increase the Architect's Basic Services for the Design Phase and Construction Phase by \$2,703,372; and,

WHEREAS, the parties intend to modify Section 4.1.5 Payment Schedule to reflect the fee increase for Design Phase and Construction Phase; and,

WHEREAS, the parties intend to revise and replace, Attachment 1 – Contract Modification Matrix and Attachment 2 – Additional Service Requests.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and the Architect agree to as follows:

A. Change Section 4.1.1, Basic Services, subsections (2), (3) and (4) as follows:

From:

"4.1.1. BASIC SERVICES

- (2) For all of the Architect's Basic Services for the Construction Phases (Article 3.3.), as described above, the Architect shall be paid a Fee not to exceed **\$24,199,365** which shall include all sub-consultant fees and direct expenses normal to the Project including

all phone calls, faxes, in-house and sub-consultant coordination, presentation, printing and reproductions-required by this Agreement. These services are not part of this Agreement, and at the City's option, will be authorized by a Modification.

- (3) The amount of Fee for the complete Basic Services of the Design Phases and Construction Phases shall not exceed **\$51,276,867**.
- (4) The Fee amount of **\$27,077,502** for Design and the Fee of **\$24,199,365** for Construction Services is hereby authorized.”

To:

“4.1.1. BASIC SERVICES

- (2) For all of the Architect's Basic Services for the Construction Phases (Article 3.3.), as described above, the Architect shall be paid a Fee not to exceed **\$27,077,502** which shall include all sub-consultant fees and direct expenses normal to the Project including all phone calls, faxes, in-house and sub-consultant coordination, presentation, printing and reproductions-required by this Agreement. These services are not part of this Agreement, and at the City's option, will be authorized by a Modification.
- (3) The amount of Fee for the complete Basic Services of the Design Phases and Construction Phases shall not exceed **\$53,980,239**.
- (4) The Fee amount of **\$27,077,502** for Design and the Fee of **\$26,902,737** for Construction Services is hereby authorized.”

B. Change Section 4.1.5, Payment Schedule, subsections (1) as follows:

From:

“4.1.5. PAYMENT SCHEDULE

- (1) The Architect will submit monthly invoices for Basic Services, including Construction Phase Services where applicable, with lump sum fees to be charged on a percentage of completion for each phase subject to the cumulative maximum per phase as noted in the Payment schedule below. The Payment Schedule represents cumulative percentages of the full not to exceed fee of **\$51,276,867** to the amount of work actually performed in that phase as determined by the City.”

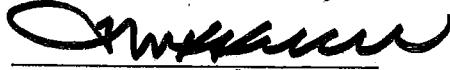

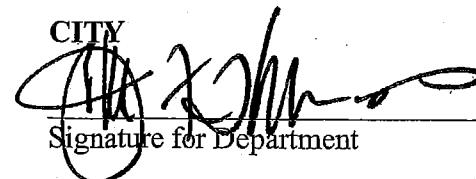

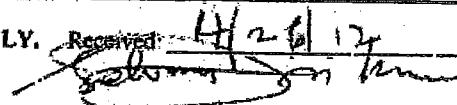
