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The requirement for Official Advertising & Clearinghouse Services was originally released for bid on April 18, 2012. However, it was "No Awarded" on May 16, 2012 in order to add language to the "Default; Remedies" contract condition which would address missed and/or misplaced ads by the newspaper and/or clearinghouse. That language was reviewed and approved by the City Attorney and added to the new contract proposal/rebid. The new contract proposal/rebid was released for bid on May 23, 2012 and bids were received on June 1, 2012.

The bids received on June 1, 2012 for TC95438 were identical to those received for TC95437 (No Award) and all Minimum Requirements were met. Therefore, the bid evaluation and point results remain unchanged and OCA's recommended awardee is *The Examiner*.

OCA regulations require that we officially recommend only responsive bidders for contract awards but the Board of Supervisors has historically used its discretion to award the Official Advertising contract to multiple bidders to best serve the City's official advertising needs.

Included in this submission are the Draft Resolution, Bid Evaluation Sheet and Ethics Forms with updated dates.

The attached table, "Summary of Official Advertising Bids for FY 12-13," shows that *The Examiner* submitted the only responsive bid for official advertising. The *San Francisco Chronicle*'s bid was non-responsive because the *San Francisco Chronicle* is not printed in San Francisco.

The total estimated contract value for FY 12-13 is \$50,000. Contract value has decreased over the last two fiscal years due to an increase in information being published on City department websites per legislative ordinance 318-10 (December 14, 2010) amending Chapter 2 of the San Francisco Administrative Code by adding Article XII, Sections 2.96 through 2.100.
