- MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Balboa Park Station Community Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions in the Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 63-12, for the terms specified:
- Catherine Hickey (residency requirement waived), seat 6, new appointment, must represent the community and economic development in the neighborhoods served by Balboa Park Station, for a two-year term to be determined.

Scott Falcone, seat 7, new appointment, must be from a land use and housing group in the neighborhoods served by Balboa Park Station, for a two-year term to be determined.

Robert Muehlbauer, seat 9, new appointment, must represent neighborhood residents' interests in the neighborhoods served by Balboa Park Station, for a two-year term to be determined.

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Balboa Park Station Community Advisory Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Catherine Hickey, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Balboa Park Station Community Advisory Committee.
- 3. The Balboa Park Station Community Advisory Committee has attempted to fill the position, for which Catherine Hickey was nominated, with an individual who is a City
