4 and Post-Release Community Supervision 2012 Implementation Plan.**

6 WHEREAS, The 2011 Public Safety Realignment Act, Assembly Bills 109 and 117
7 (AB109/117) were signed into law by Governor Edmund G. Brown on April 4, 2011, and
8 June 30, 2011, respectively, and took effect on October 1, 2011; and

9 WHEREAS, California Penal Code Section 1230.1(a) as added and amended by
10 AB109/117 requires each County's Community Corrections Partnership to recommend a local
11 plan to the County Board of Supervisors for the implementation of the 2011 Public Safety
12 Realignment Act; and

13 WHEREAS, Section 1230.1(b) further requires that an Executive Committee of the
14 Community Corrections Partnership be formed to prepare and approve presentation of the
15 plan to the Board of Supervisors, and that the Executive Committee be consisted of the Chief
16 Probation Officer, the Chief of Police, the Sheriff, the District Attorney, the Public Defender,
17 the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court or the Court's Designee, and the Head of the
18 Agency in charge of social services, mental health, or alcohol and substance abuse
19 programs, as designated by the Board of Supervisors; and

20 WHEREAS, Pursuant to 1230.1(c) the plan shall be deemed accepted by the County
21 Board of Supervisors unless rejected by a vote of 4/5th, in which case the plan goes back to
22 the Community Corrections Partnership for further consideration; and

23 WHEREAS, On August 3, 2011, the Board of Supervisors unanimously adopted resolution
24 File No. 110732, appointing the Department of Public Health to the Executive Committee of
25 the San Francisco Community Corrections Partnership for the purpose of developing an

1 implementation plan for criminal justice realignment; and

2 WHEREAS, On September 13, 2011, the Board of Supervisors unanimously adopted
3 resolution File No. 110920, approving the City and County of San Francisco 2011 Public
4 Safety Realignment Plan; and

5 WHEREAS, Since October 1, 2011, the Community Corrections Partnership Executive
6 Committee, chaired by Chief Adult Probation Officer Wendy Still, has successfully
7 implemented the City and County of San Francisco 2011 Public Safety Realignment Plan;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, A broad-based and inclusive community input process was conducted in
10 order to inform revised strategies and recommendations of the "City & County of San
11 Francisco Public Safety Realignment & Post-Release Community Supervision 2012
12 Implementation Plan"; and

13 WHEREAS, At meeting of June 1, 2012, the Community Corrections Partnership
14 Executive Committee presented and approved the "City & County of San Francisco Public
15 Safety Realignment & Post-Release Community Supervision 2012 Implementation Plan"; and

16 WHEREAS, A copy of the "City & County of San Francisco Public Safety Realignment &
17 Post-Release Community Supervision 2012 Implementation Plan" is on file with the Clerk of
18 the Board of Supervisors in File No. 120677, which is hereby declared to be part of this
19 resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That this resolution approving the "City & County of San Francisco Public
21 Safety Realignment & Post-Release Community Supervision 2012 Implementation Plan," is
22 hereby adopted by the Board of Supervisors.

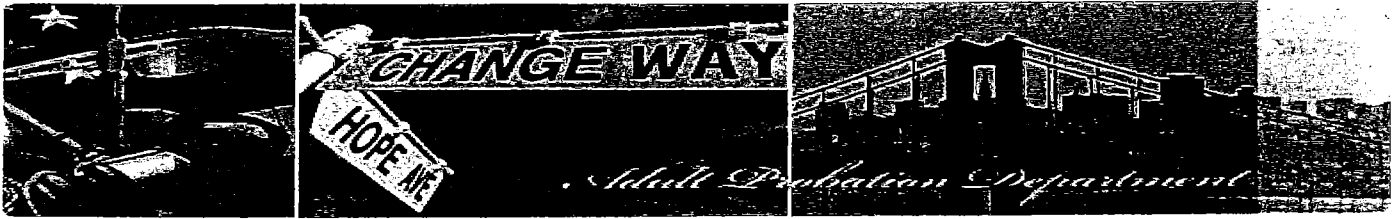

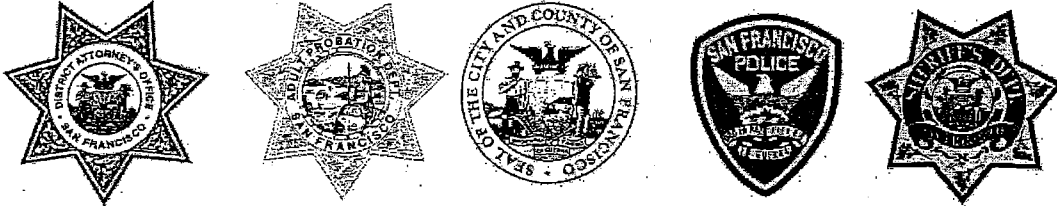
