Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Environmental Finding. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ______ and is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The San Francisco Police Code is hereby amended by amending Section 2.26, to read as follows:

SEC. 2.26 SCHEDULE OF PERMITS AND SERVICES; FILING AND SERVICE FEES.
