[Accept and Expend Gift - Polo Fields Maintenance - \$100,000]

Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend a gift from the Baker Street Foundation for \$100,000 for the salary of a gardener at the Polo Fields in Golden Gate Park for at least a year.

WHEREAS, In 2011 the Polo Fields in Golden Gate Park underwent a nearly \$1 million renovation project that improved drainage and irrigation; and

WHEREAS, The Baker Street Foundation approached the Recreation and Park Department about funding a gardener in Golden Gate Park; and

WHEREAS, These fields were once maintained by two full-time gardeners but because of budget cuts are now maintained only on a part-time basis; and

WHEREAS, Recreation and Park Department staff determined that adding gardening staff at the Polo Fields was a high priority for the department in order to preserve quality of the turf at this 16-acre sports and events complex; and

WHEREAS, Without close attention gophers, weeds and heavy athletic use will undermine the quality of the turf; and

WHEREAS, These fields are used by youth and adults from across San Francisco for soccer, lacrosse, rugby and other sports and so serve a city-wide benefit; and

WHEREAS, On February 16, 2012, the Recreation and Park Commission voted to recommend that the Board of Supervisors accept this gift; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Gift and authorizes the Recreation and Park Department General Manager to accept and expend the Gift, and to perform all acts required of the City thereunder; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions heretofore taken by the officers of the City with respect to the Gift are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation and Park General Manager to enter into any modifications to the Gift that the Recreation and Park General Manager determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interests of the City and do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Gift or this Resolution, and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including the City's Charter.
