[Findings - 3901-24th Street Disapproving Conditional Use Authorization]

Motion adopting findings supporting the Board's decision to disapprove the decision of the Planning Commission by its Motion No. 18648, approving Conditional Use Authorization identified as Planning Case No. 2011.1372C on property located at 3901 -24th Street.

WHEREAS, The appellant Leslie Crawford filed a timely appeal on February 12, 2012, protesting the approval by the Planning Commission by its Motion No. 18648, dated June 14, 2012, approving a Conditional Use Authorization identified as Planning Case No. 2011.1372C, under Planning Code Sections 728.49 and 790.110 to convert a vacant ground floor commercial space into a financial service (d.b.a.
