minutes; and

WHEREAS, In an AT&T survey, 43% of American teenage drivers admitted to texting
while driving even though 97% know it is dangerous; and
WHEREAS, A Virginia Tech Transportation Institute study showed those who send text
messages while driving are 23 times more likely to crash; and
WHEREAS, A driver who sends a text message while driving not only jeopardizes his
or her safety, but also the safety of passengers, pedestrians, and other drivers; now,
