[City Employees to Assist the Department of Elections - November 6, 2012 Consolidated

WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter section 13.104.5 prohibits City employees and officers (other than the Director of Elections, an appointee of the Director of Elections or a member of the Elections Commission) from performing "any function relating to the conduct of an election;" and,

WHEREAS, Charter section 13.104.5 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, upon the request of the Elections Commission, to waive this prohibition by motion; and,

WHEREAS, On April 18, 2012, the Elections Commission requested that the Board of Supervisors waive this prohibition to permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections with the June 5, 2012 election; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, the Board of Supervisors waives the prohibition imposed by Charter section 13.104.5, to permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections before, during and after the June 5, 2012 election.
