3	Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend a		
4	grant of \$870,355 from the San Francisco Parks Alliance for the design and		
5	construction of a playground in Sue Bierman Park.		
6			
7	WHEREAS, Sue Bierman Park is situated along the Embarcadero, covering two city		
8	blocks, bounded by the Embarcadero, Washington Street, Clay Street and Davis Street,		
9	bisected by Drumm Street; and		
10	WHEREAS, In 2004, the Recreation and Park Department led a Master Planning		
11	process for Sue Bierman Park. The community process resulted in a two-phased master		
12	plan. Construction of the first phase, which included new pathways, plantings, irrigation, new		
13	trees, and artful boulders is complete. The community discussed the inclusion of a		
14	playground as part of planning process, but at that time, a relatively new ordinance prohibited		
15	structures, including playgrounds, in Sue Bierman Park;and		
16	WHEREAS, In October of 2011 Supervisor David Chiu introduced legislation amending		
17	the ordinance to authorize the construction of playground structures on portions of Sue		
18	Bierman Park, which the Board of Supervisors' passed on December 6, 2011 and approved		
19	by the Mayor on December 7, 2011, Enactment No. 236-11; and		
20	WHEREAS, The Friends of the Waterfront Playground engaged ROMA Design, the		
21	design firm who developed the Park's 2004 Master Plan, in collaboration with Adhamina		
22	Rodriguez, to develop the conceptual design of the playground; and		
23	WHEREAS, At a community meeting held on January 24, 2012, The Friends of		
24	Waterfront Playground and the Recreation and Park Department presented a conceptual site		
25	plan for the design and construction of a playground in Sue Bierman Park; and		

1	WHEREAS, On March 15, 2012, the Recreation and Park Commission approved the		
2	conceptual plan, Resolution No.1203-004; and		
3	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Parks Alliance, acting as the fiscal agent for the		
4	Friends of Waterfront Playground, is prepared to make two grants to the City towards the		
5	design and construction of a playground in Sue Bierman Park; and		
6	WHEREAS, The breakdown of the grants are: a Grant to the Recreation and Parks		
7	Department to be used to pay for the services of one Recreation and Park Department Projec		
8	Manager to coordinate the design and construction approvals process valued at \$37,500; a		
9	Grant-in-Place of a playground valued at approximately \$832,855; and		
10	WHEREAS, on May 17, 2012, the Recreation and Park Department Commission		
11	recommended to the Board of Supervisors to accept and expend the Grant as Resolution No		
12	1205-016; and		
13	WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on		
14	program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be in		
15	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Grant and authorizes the		
16	Recreation and Park Department General Manager to accept and expend the Grant, and to		
17	perform all acts required of the City there under; and, be it		
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
19	indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it		
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions heretofore taken by the officers of the City		
21	with respect to the Grant are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified; and, be it		
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation and		
23	Park General Manager to enter into any modifications to the Grant that the Recreation and		
24	Park General Manager determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best		
25	interests of the City and do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are		

1	necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Grant or this Resolution, and are in		
2	compliance with all applicable laws, including the City's Charter.
