[Approval of a 90-Day Extension for Planning Commission Review of Rezoning of 1111 Eighth Street (File No. 111278)]

Resolution extending by 90 days the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on a proposed Ordinance (File No. 111278) that would amend the San Francisco Planning Code, Sectional Map SU08 of the Zoning Map; adding San Francisco Planning Code, Section 249.66 to establish the Art and Design Educational Special Use District at 1111 Eighth Street to facilitate the continued operation of the California College of the Arts and provide a regulatory scheme for a potential future phased expansion of the campus; and making environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan and priority policies of Planning Code, Section 101.1.

WHEREAS, On November 22, 2011, Supervisor Cohen introduced legislation to initiate the process amending San Francisco Planning Code by amending Sectional Map SU08 of the Zoning Map of the City and County of San Francisco and adding Planning Code Section 249.66 to: 1) establish the Art and Design Educational Special Use District at 1111 Eighth Street to facilitate the continued operation of the California College of the Arts and provide a regulatory scheme for a potential future phased expansion of the campus; and 2) making environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan and priority policies of Planning Code Section 101. A copy of said legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 111278 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, On or about December 8, 2011, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors initiates; and

WHEREAS, The Board, on January 31, 2012 adopted Resolution No. 34-12, which extended by 90 days the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Board, on May 8, 2012 adopted Resolution No. 170-12, which extended by 90 days the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board, on September 11, 2012 adopted Resolution No. 331-12, which extended by 90 days the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed ordinance; and
