11	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding		
12	Section 6.22(Q), to read as follows:		
13	(Q) Contractor Prompt Payment. All construction contracts under this Chapter shall		
14	require the contractor to pay its subcontractors within seven calendar days after receipt of each		
15 16	progress payment from the City, unless otherwise agreed to in writing in advance by both contractor		
17	and subcontractor. In the event that there is a good faith dispute over all or any portion of the amount		
18	due on a progress payment from a contractor to a subcontractor, the contractor may withhold the		
	disputed amount but shall pay the undisputed amount.		
19	Any contractor who violates this subsection shall pay to the subcontractor a penalty of 2% of		
20	the amount due per month for every month or portion thereof that payment is not made. This		
21	subsection is not intended to create a private right of action against the City and County of San		
22	<u>Francisco.</u>		
23	Section 2. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding		
24	Section 6.42(F), to read as follows:

1	(F) Contractor Prompt Payment. All professional services contracts under this Chapter		
2	shall require the contractor to pay its subcontractors within seven calendar days after receipt of each		
3	progress payment from the City, unless otherwise agreed to in writing in advance by both contractor		
4	and subcontractor. In the event that there is a good faith dispute over all or any portion of the amount		
5	due on a progress payment from a contractor to a subcontractor, the contractor may withhold the		
6	disputed amount but shall pay the undisputed amount.		
7	Any contractor who violates this subsection shall pay to the subcontractor a penalty of 2% of

11	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the
