WHEREAS, On July 31, 2012, Supervisor Olague introduced legislation amending the San Francisco Planning Code: by: 1) adding Section 744.1 to establish the Fillmore Street Neighborhood Commercial District along Fillmore Street between Bush and Fulton Streets; 2) amending Section 151.1, a portion of Table 151.1, Section 263.20, and Section 607.1(f) to make conforming and other technical changes; 3) amending Sheets ZN02 and ZN07 of the Zoning Map to rezone specified properties to the Fillmore Street Neighborhood Commercial District; and 4) adopting environmental findings, Planning Code Section 302 findings, and findings of consistency with the General Plan and the Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of said legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 120814 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

1	WHEREAS, On or about August 10, 2012, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
2	referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the
3	proposed ordinance; and
4	WHEREAS, On or about October 25, 2012, the Planning Commission continued the
5	proposed Ordinance to the November 29, 2012 Planning Commission hearing at the request
6	of Supervisor Olague; and
7	WHEREAS, On or about October 30, 2012, the Board of Supervisors passed
8	Resolution 121052 extending the Planning Commission's review period for the proposed
9	Ordinance for an additional 45 days to December 7, 2012; and
10	WHEREAS, On or about November 29, 2012, the Planning Commission continued the
11	proposed Ordinance to the December 13, 2012 Planning Commission hearing at the request
12	of Supervisor Olague; and
13	WHEREAS, On or about December 11, 2012, the Board of Supervisors passed
14	Resolution 121177 extending the Planning Commission's review period for the proposed
15	Ordinance for an additional 30 days to January 10, 2012; and
16	WHEREAS, On or about December 13, the Planning Commission continued the
17	proposed Ordinance to the January 10, 2013 Planning Commission hearing at the request of
18	Supervisor Olague; and
19	WHEREAS, On or about January 8, 2013, Supervisor Breed notified the Clerk of the
20	Board of Supervisors that as the new Supervisor for District Five she will be taking over
21	sponsorship of the proposed Ordinance; and
22	WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by
23	Resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its
