10	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding		
11	Section 10.100-225, to read as follows:		
12	SECTION 10.100-225. PUBLIC UTILITIES WATER ENTERPRISE CAPITAL COST		
13	RECOVERY PAYMENT SURCHARGE FUND.		
14	(a) Establishment of Fund. The Water Enterprise Capital Cost Recovery Payment Surcharge		
15	Fund is established as a category eight fund for the purpose of receiving capital cost recovery payment		
16	surcharge proceeds collected	from wholesale water customers by the San Francisco Public Utilities	
17	Commission. Section 5.03.F	of the July, 2009 "Water Supply Agreement Between the City and County	
18	of San Francisco and Wholes	ale Customers in Alameda County, San Mateo County and Santa Clara	
19	County" approved in San Francisco Public Utilities Commission Resolution Number 09-0069 adopted		
20	on April 28, 2009 allows the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's wholesale water customers		
21	to prepay the balance of "Exi	sting Regional Asset" capital costs. California Water Code section	
22	81438(b) authorizes the San	Francisco Public Utilities Commission to collect a surcharge from its	
23	wholesale water customers to pay required debt service and other costs associated with the issuance of		
24	revenue bonds by the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency for the purpose of funding the		

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1	advance prepayment of Existing Regional Asset costs to San Francisco. Section 3.03(b) of the January		
2	1, 2013 "Prepayment and Collection Agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and the		
3	Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency" requires the creation of a restricted reserve fund for		
4	the use and administration of Capital Cost Recovery Payment Surcharge proceeds as set forth in		
5	subsections (b) and (c).		
6	(b) Use of the Fund. Money received into the fund shall be used exclusively for the deposit		
7	and remittance of Capital Cost Recovery Payment Surcharge proceeds by the San Francisco Public		
8	<u>Utilities Commission to the Trustee for the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency revenue</u>		
9	bonds in accordance with the terms of the January 1, 2013 Prepayment and Collection Agreement		
10	referenced in subsection (a) above.		
11	(c) Administration of Fund. The fund shall be maintained from July 1, 2013 through July 1,		
12	2036 the termination date of the Wholesale Water Revenue Prepayment and Collection		
13	Agreement.
