8	(NCD) for an additional three years and apply it to an area within one-quarter mile of the
9	boundaries of the NCD; adding Section 788, to establish the Lower Polk Street Alcohol

12	O'Farrell Street and Van Ness Avenue; amending the Zoning Map, Map Sheet ZN-02, to

17	WHEREAS, On October 30, 2012, Supervisor Chiu introduced legislation amending the
18	San Francisco Planning Code by (1) amending Section 723 to extend the restriction of
19	Tobacco Paraphernalia Establishments in the Polk Street Neighborhood Commercial District
20	(NCD) for an additional three years and apply it to an area within one-quarter mile of the
21	boundaries of the NCD, (2) adding Section 788 to establish the Lower Polk Street Alcohol
22	Restricted Use District for the properties located on Polk Street between California and
23	O'Farrell Streets, and Polk Street's side streets between California Street, Larkin Street,
24	O'Farrell Street and Van Ness Avenue, (3) amending the Zoning Map to designate the Lower
25	Polk Street Alcohol Restricted Use District on Map Sheet ZN-02, and (4) making

1	environmental findings, Planning Code Section 302 findings, and findings of consistency with
2	the General Plan and the Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of said
3	legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 121065. NOW
4	THEREFORE BE IT
5	RESOLVED, That by this Resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed time
6	within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed Ordinance for
7	approximately 60 additional days, until April 2, 2013.
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
