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



Statement of Qualifications

Currently I am the Director of Food Systems for the San Francisco Department of Public Health, where I focus on health equity and food systems through city wide food system research, policy and planning specifically focusing on the areas food security; utilization, quality and effectiveness of government nutrition programs, improving child nutrition through nutrition assistance programs, public policy supporting healthy food environments, and urban rural connections. My work focuses on supporting healthy nutrition for all San Franciscans.

I have been involved in food systems in San Francisco in a variety of capacities for 15 years. Immediately prior to my position at the Department of Public Health, I founded and led the non profit, San Francisco Food Systems where we focused on research, advocacy and policy to improve access to high quality food especially for low income San Franciscans through school meals, farmers markets and especially the utilization of federal nutrition benefits, food assessments, and community capacity building. Prior to that, I was the Director of Urban Agriculture at the San Francisco League of Urban Gardeners focusing on food security through urban farming in public housing developments, farmers markets in low-income communities, food pantries, and youth gardening and job training, and food security assessments in San Francisco's Southeast Sector.

I have participated in the San Francisco Food Security Task Force since 2005, as a regularly attending member of the public, and since 2009 I have served as staff to the task force. Since 2010, I have also served as a member to the task force.



Board Qualifications:

The Food Security Task Force shall consist of up to 15 members as provided below. Members, other than department representatives and the School District representative, shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

The Board of Supervisors shall appoint one member from the Department of Human Services of the Human Service Agency, the Department of Public Health- Nutrition Services, the Department of Aging and Adult Services of the Human Services Agency, the Department of Public Health-Office of Food Systems, the Department of Children, Youth and their Families and the Department of Environment Urban Agriculture. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall invite the San Francisco Unified School District to submit a representative for appointment by the Board as a member of the Task Force.

In addition, the Board may appoint as members of the Task Force up to eight representatives of community-based organizations that provide nutritional support and increase the food security of San Francisco residents. Such community members shall be nominated by the Task Force and may include but are not limited to representatives from organizations serving food in the following program types: home-delivered meals; congregate meals for seniors; food bank; free dining room; multi-service agency serving families and youth; shelter meals; and faith-based organizations, food retail (farmers markets; grocery stores); hospital and health clinics and a member of the public. No organization shall have more than one representative on the Task Force.

San Francisco BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Purposes of Task Force: The Food Security Task Force shall recommend to the Board of Supervisors legislative action and city-wide strategies that would increase participation in federally funded programs such as CalFresh known nationally as SNAP and formally as food stamps, Summer Food Service, the Child and Adult Care Food Program, the Homeless Children Nutrition Program, the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC), the School Lunch Program and the National School Breakfast Program. The Task Force shall also provide general advice and assistance to the Board of Supervisors with regard to funding priorities, legislative action, and city policies on addressing hunger and enhancing the food security of San Francisco residents in addition to any other issues within the Task Force's expertise.

To accomplish these goals, the Food Security Task Force shall prepare an annual assessment of the state of hunger and food insecurity in San Francisco with recommendations for funding, programs, and policy. The Task Force shall submit the hunger and food insecurity assessment to the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors may adopt legislation to implement the recommendations.

Reports: The Task Force shall submit status reports to the Board bi-annually.

Sunset Date: The Task Force shall sunset on July 1, 2015 unless extended by the Board of Supervisors resolution.
