3 **Ordinance amending the Police Code to rescind the authorization for the Police**
4 **Department to be a member of the National Rifle Association or to collect or expend**
5 **tournament fees for the National Rifle Association.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The San Francisco Police Code is hereby amended by repealing
12 Sections 1357 and 1358 and by amending Section 1359, to read as follows:

13 ~~**SEC. 1357. MEMBERSHIP IN NATIONAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION.**~~

14 ~~*The Police Department of the City and County of San Francisco is hereby authorized to hold*~~
15 ~~*membership in the National Rifle Association and the cost of the said membership shall be paid from*~~
16 ~~*such funds as may be appropriated or set aside for that purpose.*~~

18 ~~**SEC. 1358. NATIONAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION FEES.**~~

19 ~~*The Chief of Police is also authorized to collect and receive registration fees prescribed by the*~~
20 ~~*Rules and Regulations of the National Rifle Association and on behalf of said Association in connection*~~
21 ~~*with the holding of the firearms tournaments. The said fees shall be deposited in and paid from the*~~
22 ~~*"Police Range Fund."*~~

24 **SEC. 1359. DISBURSEMENTS FROM POLICE RANGE FUND.**

25 Money deposited in the Police Range Fund shall be disbursed in the following order:

1 (a) In the payment of taxes collected pursuant to Section 1354 of this Article.

2 ~~(b) In the payment to the National Rifle Association or its order, of fees collected pursuant to~~
3 ~~Section 1358 of this Article.~~

4 (b) ~~(e)~~ In the payment of purchases of trophies, medals and prizes and the payment of
5 such incidental tournament costs or purchase of such training equipment as may be
6 authorized by the Police Commission.

7 (c) ~~(d)~~ In payment of police personnel and maintenance and other costs incurred in
8 training persons in the use of firearms for which a fee is charged pursuant to Section 1351.1.

9
10 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the
11 date of passage.

12
13 Section 3. This section is uncodified. In enacting this Ordinance, the Board intends to
14 amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers,
15 punctuation, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent part of the Police Code that are
16 explicitly shown in this legislation as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and
17 Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title
18 of the legislation.
