- 3 (b) Establishment of the Lower Polk Street Alcohol Restricted Use District. In order to
- 4 preserve the residential character and the neighborhood-serving commercial uses of the area, the
- 5 Lower Polk Street Alcohol Restricted Use District is hereby established for the properties located on
- 6 Polk Street between California Street to the north, O'Farrell Street to the south, and Polk Street's side
- 7 streets between, but not including, Van Ness Avenue and Larkin Street to the west and east, and
- 8 *between, but not including, California Street to the north and O'Farrell Street to the south. The Lower*

- 12 (1) A "liquor establishment" shall mean any enterprise selling alcoholic beverages, as
- 13 *defined by California Business & Professions Code Section 23004 and 23025, pursuant to a California*
- 14 <u>Alcoholic Beverage Control Board license. It shall not be interpreted to mean an establishment that (A)</u>
- 15 *operates as a Bona Fide Eating Place, as defined in Section 790.142 of this Code, or (B) operates as an*
- 16 <u>"other retail sales and service" use that sells general groceries or specialty groceries, as defined in</u>
- 17 *Planning Code Section 790.102 (a) or (b), respectively.*
- 18 (2) An "off sale liquor establishment" shall mean a Liquor Store as defined in Planning
- 19 <u>Code Section 790.55.</u>
- 20 (3) An "on sale liquor establishment" shall mean a Bar as defined in Planning Code
- 21 <u>Section 790.22.</u>
- 22 (*d*) Controls.
- 23 (1) No new on-sale or off-sale liquor establishment shall be permitted in the Lower Polk
- 24 <u>Street Alcohol Restricted Use District; provided that a liquor establishment located in the Lower Polk</u>
- 25 <u>Street Alcohol Restricted Use District may transfer its alcohol license to another site, either within or</u>

1	outside the Lower Polk Street Alcohol Restricted Use District; provided further that a liquor
2	establishment located outside the Lower Polk Street Alcohol Restricted Use District shall not transfer
3	any alcohol license to a liquor establishment located within the Lower Polk Street Alcohol Restricted
4	Use District; and provided further that any transfer of a liquor license to a new location within the
5	Lower Polk Street Alcohol Restricted Use District shall require a conditional use permit for the new
6	liquor establishment.
7	(2) Whenever a liquor establishment has discontinued its use for a continuous period of
8	one year or more, the liquor establishment shall be deemed to have abandoned its use as a liquor
9	establishment; provided that a break in continuous operation shall not be interpreted to include the
10	following, as long as the location of the establishment does not change, the square footage used for the
11	sale of alcoholic beverages does not increase, and the type of California Department of Alcoholic
12	Beverage Control Liquor License ("ABC License") does not change:
13	(A) Re-establishment, restoration or repair of an existing liquor establishment
14	on the same lot after total or partial destruction or damage due to fire, riot, insurrection, toxic accident
15	or other force majeure; or
16	(B) Temporary closure of an existing liquor establishment for repair, renovation
17	or remodeling, provided that permit applications for the repair, renovation or remodeling work shall
18	be submitted to the City upon or prior to the temporary closure and such permits and work shall be
19	pursued diligently to completion; or
20	(C) A change in ownership of a Liquor Establishment or an owner-to-owner
21	transfer of an ABC License.
22	(3) New Restaurants with Types 47 and 49 liquor licenses may operate past 12:00
23	midnight provided that the Restaurant serves food in the following manner, until the time it closes:
24	
25	

1	(A) It continues to serve meals to guests for compensation and has available
2	kitchen facilities connected therewith, for cooking of an assortment of foods which may be required for
3	ordinary meals; and
4	(B) "Meals" that are offered after midnight shall mean an assortment of foods
5	commonly ordered at various hours of the day for breakfast, lunch or dinner. Incidental food service,
6	comprised only of appetizers to accompany drinks, is not considered a meal. Incidental, sporadic or
7	infrequent sales of meals or a mere offering of meals without actual sales is not compliance; and
8	(C) "Guests" shall mean persons who come to the Restaurant after midnight for
9	the purpose of obtaining, and actually order and obtain at such time, a meal therein. Nothing in this
10	section, however, shall be construed to require that any food be sold or purchased with any beverage.
11	(e) Sunset Provision. This Section 788 shall be repealed five (5) years after its initial Effective
12	Date unless the Board of Supervisors, on or before that date, extends or re-enacts it.
13	Section 4. The Zoning Map of the City and County of San Francisco shall be amended
14	by amending Sectional Map ZN-02 to establish the boundaries of the Lower Polk Alcohol
15	Restricted Use District and shall include the properties located between, but not including,
16	Van Ness Avenue, Larkin Street, O'Farrell Street and California Street, which includes the
17	following Assessor's Block Numbers, but shall not include the lots within these Assessor's
18	Block Numbers that front on Van Ness Avenue, Larkin Street, O'Farrell Street and California
19	Street:
20	Assessor's Block Numbers 0645, 0646, 0667, 0668, 0669, 0670, 0691, 0692, 0693,
21	0694, 0715, and 0716.
22	Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the
23	date of passage.

1	Section 6. Applicability Date. This ordinance shall not apply to any liquor
2	establishment that has filed a complete application for a liquor license with the California
3	Alcoholic Beverage Control Board prior to the Effective Date of this Ordinance.
4	Section 7. This section is uncodified. In enacting this ordinance, the Board intends to
5	amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers,
6	punctuation, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent part of the Planning Code that are
7	explicitly shown in this legislation as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and
8	Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title
9	of the legislation.
