RESOLUTION NO.

Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general license from 201 Leland Avenue to 500 Laguna Street (District 5), to Krista Avery and Manuel Bargiela for O Camino, dba Nosa Ria, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.

WHEREAS, Krista Avery and Manuel Bargiela are seeking the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general license from 201 Leland Avenue to 500 Laguna Street for O Camino, dba Nosa Ria; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed one (1) protest with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. each day of the week; 2) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee as depicted on ABC-257; 3) Loitering (defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") shall be prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises

under the control of the licensee(s) as depicted on the ABC-257 dated October 19, 2012; 4) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such light shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences; 5) No person under the age of 21 shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages; 6) The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 200 ml shall be strictly prohibited; 7) No sales of malt liquors or ice beers; 8) Beer, malt beverages, and wine coolers of 16oz. or less shall not be sold in single containers, and must be sold in manufacturers pre-packaged multi-unit quantities; 9) No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of greater than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more; 10) Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml; and 11) The petitioner shall utilize electronic surveillance and recording equipment that is able to view the outside of the premises, including all entrances and exits, and that is actively monitored and recorded. The electronic surveillance shall be utilized during operating hours. Said electronic recording shall be kept at least 30 days and shall be made available to the Department or Police Department upon demand; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general license from 201 Leland Avenue to 500 Laguna Street to Krista Avery and Manuel Bargiela for O Camino, dba Nosa Ria, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts Police Department recommendations one

through 10, listed above, but does not endorse or adopt condition 11 (requiring electronic surveillance), and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the license without condition 11.

#### Dear Officer Frias:

My partner, Manuel, and I are the co-owners of Nosa Ría Market located at 500 Laguna Street in Hayes Valley. We have applied to the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for a Type-21 Off-Sale General License. This type of license authorizes the sale of beer, wine and spirits for consumption off the premises where sold.

Nosa Ria Marker is a new specialty food store located in Hayes Valley. The store is a unique Spanish food shop, with a distinct offering that includes authentic, high-quality products sourced from Spain. The store offers an assortment of products including cured meats, fresh cheese, dry goods, canned and preserved foods, oils, vinegars, spices, sweets, as well as kitchenwares and cookbooks. We are looking to complement our selection of food items with a small, well-curated selection of Spanish wines, sherries and ciders in order to address the demand that our customers have expressed for hard to find Spanish products.

In mid-February, we received the draft conditions for the license from our ABC contact, Joan Bernandino. There are three conditions to which we would respectfully like to request a modification. I contacted Inspector Von Koll in order to discuss the modifications, and he suggested that firstly, I obtain community support for the license, and secondly, that I work with you to gain your support, as our Northern Station liaison.

I have obtained letters of support from the following community members:

- Russell Pritchard, President, Hayes Valley Merchants Association
- Larry Cronander, Chairman of Business Relations Committee, Hayes Valley Neighborhood Association
- London Breed, Supervisor District 5

Before discussing modifications to the conditions, it is important to set context of the alcoholic beverages that we envision selling. The alcoholic beverages will represent less than 10% of our inventory assortment. We plan to stock a very small assortment of approximately 10-15 alcoholic beverages such as:

- Three (3) types of white wine, generally less than 15% alcohol by volume.
- Three (3) types of red wine, generally less than 15% alcohol by volume.
- Two (2) types of sparkling wine, generally less than 15% alcohol by volume.

- Two (2) types of Sherry wine, generally 17% 20% alcohol by volume.
- Two (2) types of cider, generally less than 7% alcohol by volume.

The price points for the beverages above will likely range from approximately \$25 - \$60 per bottle.

Regarding modification of three conditions, we would like to request the following:

#### Condition #1 –

Currently states: "Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 11:00 to 7:00 pm Tuesday through Sunday.

Given that there are some events during the year hosted by the Hayes Valley Merchant Association, such as the Annual Holiday Block Party in December, where merchants stay open until 9:00 pm, we would like to have the language of the condition modified to read:

Modified language requested: "Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 11:00 to 9:00 pm Tuesday through Sunday.

#### Condition #10 -

Currently states: "No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of greater than 15% by volume".

We would like to offer a wine that is a specialty of Spain called Jerez (or Sherry). This wine is a fortified wine, generally with alcoholic content between 17-20% by volume. Our letters of support specifically address that the sale of Sherry wine is an important factor for our store because it is a hard-to-find product that customers have expressed great interest in, which will bring customers to Hayes Valley.

Modification requested: We would like to have this condition removed.

#### Condition #12 -

Currently states: "The petitioner shall utilize electronic surveillance and recording equipment that is able to view the outside of the premises, including all entrances and exits, and that is actively monitored and recorded. This electronic surveillance shall be utilized during operating hours. Said electronic recording shall be kept at least 30 days and shall be made available to the Department and Police Department upon demand."

We respect that electronic surveillance is viewed as an important safety measure; however, the installation expense is a significant financial burden for our small business and an inequitable request as our fellow merchants in the neighborhood who sell larger amounts of alcoholic beverages do not have such surveillance. Please note that there will be no signs, posters, or other items on doors or windows advertising that we sell alcoholic beverages.

Modification requested: We would like to have this condition removed,

If any of the requested modifications require negotiation, I am very open to engaging in conversations so that we can come to a compromise. Thank you for your consideration of this request.

#### Dear Ms. Calvillo:

My partner, Manuel, and I are the co-owners of Nosa Ría Market in Hayes Valley. We have applied to the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for a Type-21 Off-Sale General License. This type of license authorizes the sale of beer, wine and spirits for consumption off the premises where sold. Minors are allowed on the premises.

Nosa Ría Market is a new specialty food store located in Hayes Valley. We opened our doors at the end of August 2012, and we have enjoyed a very warm welcome from the neighborhood, residents and merchants alike. Our mission is to spread our passion for Spanish foods and wines by educating our customers about the flavors and culture of Spain and enriching people's lives through our specialty food store. The store is a unique Spanish food shop, with a distinct offering that includes authentic, high-quality products sourced solely from Spain. The store offers a well-rounded assortment of products including dry goods, canned and jarred foods, fresh cheeses, cured meats, and sweets. Nosa Ría Market also offers kitchenware, including ceramics, cookware and cookbooks. We are looking to complement our selection of food items with a small, well-curated selection of Spanish wines, sherries and ciders in order to address the demand that our customers have expressed for hard to find Spanish products for cooking and enjoying with foods.

Our products set us apart from other specialty food stores and grocery stores in San Francisco. Nosa Ría Market is the first and only specialty food store in San Francisco specializing in foods imported from Spain. People who shop with us know that we have a passion for good food and that we listen and respond to their requests and queries about their favorite products from Spain. We are sharing with our customers the quintessential foods of Spain that have been served on Spanish tables for thousands of years, but have been under-represented in the U.S. market and in San Francisco. Our customers are largely people who either live and/or work in the San Francisco area who are looking for unique, wholesome foods and wines, Sherries and ciders for preparing and enjoying meals at home, or for sharing with friends and family. Many of our customers live in Hayes Valley and simply walk a few blocks to shop with us; others live in one of San Francisco's diverse neighborhoods and ride their bike, take public transportation or drive to visit us. We also have many customers who live in the greater Bay Area, who make the trip to enjoy a day in The City. A large number of our customers have shown great interest, and have specifically requested, for us to sell Spanish

wines, sherries and ciders for cooking and to pair with meals that they are planning at home. Our goal is to offer customers a small selection of unique and hard-to-find Spanish wines, sherries and ciders that will enhance the authenticity and experience of their meals at home. These Spanish wines, sherries and ciders are products that customers <u>cannot find elsewhere</u> in San Francisco or the greater Bay Area. Offering these highly unique, hard-to-find products <u>will bring San Franciscans</u> and <u>Bay Area residents to Hayes Valley</u> for a local shopping experience.

Nosa Ría is owned and operated by the founders Krista Avery and Manuel Bargiela, both long-time residents of San Francisco. The business is registered with the City and County of San Francisco as Doing Business As Nosa Ría. The parent company is O Camiño, an S Corporation registered in the State of California. Nosa Ría Market is located at 500 Laguna Street, San Francisco, CA 94102. We have approximately 500 square feet of retail space in a historic building at the corner of Laguna Street and Fell Street. Our business hours of operation are: Tuesday through Saturday, 11am – 7pm, Sunday, 11 am – 5pm, closed on Monday.

We are seeking approval by the Board of Supervisors for this double-transfer license (person-to-person and premise-to-premise). The transferors' address is: 201 Leland Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94134. Approval of the license transfer will allow for Nosa Ría Market to be an even greater asset to Hayes Valley and the San Francisco community. The approval by the board would not have any detrimental effect on the surrounding neighborhood or the city of San Francisco. We are committed to meaningful relationships with our customers, suppliers and the community. Although sales are essential for a profitable business, strong, meaningful, productive relationships are the cornerstone of our business. Our relationships are based on respect and courtesy.

We respectfully request that this letter be forwarded to the City Operations and Neighborhood Services Committee of the Board of Supervisors and that this Committee and the full Board of Supervisors make a determination that the public need or convenience would be served by the transfer of the Type-21 General License to O Camiño DBA Nosa Ría at 500 Laguna Street, San Francisco, CA 94102.
