GRANT INDIRECT COSTS

Per grant requirements, applicants could not request more than 15% of the total possible grant award in indirect costs. The state allowed San Francisco to apply for a maximum award of \$568,800. As such, the total indirect costs for which San Francisco was eligible was \$85,320 (\$568,800 x 15% = \$85,320).
