8	WHEREAS, The Electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition				
9	J in November 1976, allowing City and County Departments to contract with private compani				
10	for specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar work by City ar				
11	County employees (Charter Section 10.104.15); and				
12	WHEREAS, The Controller has determined that a Purchaser's award of a contract for				
13	the services listed below to a private contractor will continue to achieve substantial cost savings				
14	for the City; and				
15	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco must reconcile a projected \$129				
16	million budget deficit for FY2013-2014 with a Charter obligation to enact a balanced budge				
17	each fiscal year; and				
18	WHEREAS, The Mayor has determined that the state of the City's budget for FY2013-				
19	2014 as indicated herein has created an emergency situation justifying a Purchaser's award of				
20	a contract for night and weekend security services for SFPUC's offices on 525 Golden Gate				
21	Avenue, and				
22	WHEREAS, The Controller's certification, which confirms that said services can be				
23	performed at lower costs to the City and County by private contractor than by employees of the				
24	City and County, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130379, which				
25	is hereby declared to be part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore be it;				

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Mayor's determination that the state of the City's budget for fiscal year 2013-14 as indicated herein has created an emergency situation and concurs with the Controller's certification and approves the Proposition J Resolution concerning the Purchaser's award of a contract to a private contractor for the services listed below for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.
