3	Motion appointing Deborah Muise and Raija Freeman, residency requirement waived,
4	terms ending November 23, 2014, to the Shelter Monitoring Committee.

6	MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
7	hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Shelter
8	Monitoring Committee, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 283-04 and Article XII of
9	Article 20 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, for the terms specified:
10	Deborah Muise, seat 2, succeeding Jennie Parrilla, resigned, must be homeless or
11	formerly homeless within the 3 years prior to appointment, with a disability, for the unexpired
12	portion of a two-year term ending November 23, 2014.
13	Raija Freeman, seat 6 (residency requirement waived), succeeding Will Daley,
14	resigned, must be selected from a list of candidates that are nominated by non-profit agencies
15	that provide advocacy or organizing services to homeless people, for the unexpired portion of
16	a two-year term ending November 23, 2014.
17	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:
18	1. The membership of the Shelter Monitoring Committee has a goal to be
19	representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
20	2. Applicant Raija Freeman, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco,
21	is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Shelter
22	Monitoring Committee.
23	3. The Shelter Monitoring Committee has attempted to fill the position, for which Raija
24	Freeman was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the
25	specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this

1	time. The Rules Committee has certified that Raija Freeman is qualified to serve on
2	the Shelter Monitoring Committee.

- After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Shelter Monitoring Committee at this time; and, be it FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Raija Freeman, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
