[Urging the California State Legislature to Pass Assembly Bill 1266]

Resolution urging the California State Legislature to pass AB 1266, the School Success and Opportunity Act.

WHEREAS, Gender Identity is a person's internal, deeply-rooted identification, and the freedom to express this identification is critical to a person's health, well-being, development and success; and

WHEREAS, Despite current California law which prohibits discrimination against students based on their gender identity, many school districts are not presently in compliance with these requirements; and

WHEREAS, Transgender youth must often overcome significant stigma and challenges when forced to participate in or be relegated to activities or facilities which are inconsistent with their gender identity; and

WHEREAS, The suppression, invalidation and undermining of a young person's gender identity is incongruous with our commitment to providing a healthy learning environment for our children; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco recognizes the importance of giving our transgender and gender non-conforming youth equal opportunities for growth, respect, success and support; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1266 would provide California School Districts with a clear understanding of the legal obligations to integrate transgender students into every aspect of schooling according to their gender identity: now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors supports and encourages the California State Assembly to pass Assembly Bill 1266 and ensure equal opportunities for success to our transgender youth.
