

1 [Contract - MedImpact Healthcare Systems, Inc. - \$28,291,346]

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3 **Resolution approving a contract between the Department of Public Health and**  
4 **MedImpact Healthcare Systems, Inc., to provide Pharmacy Benefits Management**  
5 **Services, including computerized approval of prescriptions at a network of community**  
6 **pharmacies for Community Behavioral Health Services clients who do not have**  
7 **prescription drug insurance, in the amount of \$28,291,346 for the term of July 1, 2013,**  
8 **through June 30, 2018.**

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10 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health desires to provide automated approval of  
11 prescriptions from Community Behavioral Health Services providers for clients without  
12 prescription drug insurance at community pharmacies; and

13 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has conducted a Request for Proposals  
14 for such services; and

15 WHEREAS, This contract is proposed to be in the amount of \$28,291,346, thus  
16 exceeding ten million dollars (\$10,000,000); and,

17 WHEREAS, Section 9.118 of the San Francisco Charter requires that such contracts  
18 be approved by the Board of Supervisors; and

19 WHEREAS, A copy of this agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
20 Supervisors in File No. 130513, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if  
21 set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Public  
23 Health and the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser, on behalf of the  
24 City and County of San Francisco, to contract with the MedImpact Healthcare Systems, Inc.  
25 for the period July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2018, to provide Pharmacy Benefits

1 Management services, including computerized approval of prescriptions at a network of  
2 community pharmacies for from Community Behavioral Health Services clients who do not  
3 have prescription drug insurance, in the amount of \$28,291,346; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director  
5 of Health and the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser to make  
6 amendments to this contract, as needed.
