**Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to reduce video and digital video disc fees and to increase reproduction of photographs for commercial purposes.**

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 8.21-2, to read as follows:

**SEC. 8.21-2. LIBRARY FEES AND FINES.**

(a) Fee Schedule. The Library Commission is hereby authorized to charge fines and fees for the use of library materials and services in accordance with the following schedule:
