A copy of said motion is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 120357.
 - (b) On May 23, 2013, the Planning Commission conducted a duly noticed public hearing on the proposed Zoning Map amendments and, by Resolution No. 18884, recommended them for approval. The Planning Commission found that the proposed Zoning Map amendments were, on balance, consistent with the City's General Plan, as it is proposed for amendment, and with Planning Code Section 101.1(b). A copy of said Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 120360 and is incorporated herein by reference.
 - (c) Pursuant to Planning Code Section 302, this Board finds that these Zoning Map amendments will serve the public necessity, convenience, and welfare for the reasons set forth in Planning Commission Resolution No. 18884 and the Board incorporates such reasons herein by reference.
