15	Francisco meet its sustainability goals; and		
16	WHEREAS, Organizations making donations of materials are long-time supporters of		
17	San Francisco's sustainability goals; and		
18	Whereas, Webcor Builders and Rana Creek donated a Living Wall valued at \$30,000;

20	Whereas, Finelight donated energy efficiency task lights valued at \$26,500; and		
21	Whereas, Lucid donated energy monitoring software valued at \$17,715; and		
22	Whereas, Lutron donated automatic window shades valued at \$22,385; and
