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previously approved by the Board of Supervisors.

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3 Motion directing the Budget and Legislative Analyst to conduct three performance 4 audits in 2013 and setting the priority as follows: 1) the San Francisco Fire 5 Department's recruitment, retention, and overtime staffing; 2) the Department of 6 Children, Youth and Their Families implementation of the Children's Fund including an 7 evaluation of the role of the Children's Fund Citizens' Advisory Committee; and 3) the 8 Department of Public Health's compliance with privacy and security regulations as defined by the Heath Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health 10 (HITECH) and Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) acts; and removing from the Budget and Legislative Analyst's audit plan the management and 12 oversight of the former San Francisco Redevelopment Agency's assets and functions,

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WHEREAS, It is the policy of the Board of Supervisors that each program of the City and County of San Francisco be the subject of a performance audit at least once every eight years; and

WHEREAS, The function of regular performance audits is to ensure that City departments and agencies make prudent and efficient use of City resources and also effectively perform the functions assigned to them by the Chart and applicable laws; and now be it;

MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst is hereby directed as a first priority to conduct a performance audit of the San Francisco Fire Department's (1) recruitment and retention of uniform staff; and (2) use of overtime to meet fire suppression and ambulance staffing requirements; and

1	MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst is hereby directed as a second
2	priority to conduct a performance audit of the Department of Children, Youth and Their
3	Families implementation of the Children's Fund including an evaluation of the role of the
4	Children's Fund Citizens' Advisory Committee; and
5	MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst is hereby directed as a third priority
6	to conduct a performance audit of the Department of Public Health's compliance with privacy
7	and security regulations as defined by the Heath Information Technology for Economic and
8	Clinical Health (HITECH) and Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA)
9	acts, with a focus on the data systems and records management at Laguna Honda Hospital
10	and San Francisco General Hospital; and, be it
11	FURTHER MOVED, That the performance audit of the transfer of the former San
12	Francisco Redevelopment Agency's (SFRA) assets and functions to the City, previously
13	approved by the Board of Supervisors (Motion 12-0148) is removed from the Budget and
14	Legislative Analyst's Audit Plan.
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
