[Urging the California State Legislature to Pass Local Control Funding Formula]

WHEREAS, After years of budget cuts, California ranks 47th out of 50 among states in per-pupil spending; and

WHEREAS, The Local Control Funding Formula, as proposed by Governor Brown, will increase flexibility and accountability at the local level, reduce state bureaucracy, and ensure that student needs drive the allocation of resources; and

WHEREAS, Under the Local Control Funding Formula, California's statewide average of \$6,656 in per-pupil spending could grow to as much as \$10,450 within five years, according to the San Francisco Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, the Local Control Funding Formula addresses a fundamental civil rights issue by channeling additional dollars to low-income students and English-learners; and

WHEREAS, Support for the Local Control Funding Formula includes Mayor Edwin Lee, Superintendent Richard Carranza, the San Francisco Chamber of Commerce, the California Teachers Association, and dozens of civic leaders, Superintendents, and organizations from around the State; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the California State Legislature to pass the Local Control Funding Formula in the 2013-2014 California State Budget as proposed by Governor Jerry Brown.
