Ordinance 188-75. Amended by Ordinance 49-87; Ordinance 429-97; Elections Code Section 600.

## **Board Qualifications:**

The Ballot Simplification Committee consists of a total of six members, five of whom are voting members, three of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors.

The composition of the other members are as follows: Two voting members whom shall be appointed by the Mayor. The City Attorney, or his or her designated representative, shall be an ex officio member and shall have a voice but no vote in committee proceedings. Each appointive member shall be a registered San Francisco voter, shall possess an understanding of ballot issues and shall possess writing skills and training which provide for a high capability in written communication to the general public.

Of the two members to be appointed by the Mayor, one shall be appointed from persons whose names have been submitted by The Pacific Media Workers Guild and one shall be an educational reading specialist recommended by the Superintendent of Schools of the San Francisco Unified School District. Two of the three members appointed by the Board of Supervisors shall be appointed from persons whose names have been submitted by the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences, Northern California Chapter, or the Northern California Broadcasters Association. The third member appointed by the Board of Supervisors shall be appointed from persons whose names have been submitted by the League of Women Voters of San Francisco.

# San Francisco BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Committee shall have the power and duty to (1) prepare a digest of each measure that will be voted on only in the City and County of San Francisco; (2) Assist the Director of Elections in preparing the additional materials set forth in Article V of the Elections Code (Elections Materials mailed to the Voter). In the exercise of its powers and duties, the Committee shall have access to any appropriate officer, department, board or commission of the City and County for consultation and assistance. When preparing a digest, the Committee shall give consideration to the analyses prepared by departments pursuant to Section 350 of the Elections Code (requiring Departments to transmit an analysis of initiative measures to the Ballot Simplification Committee).

Reports: Digest of any local measure which is to be voted on at any election in the City and County.
