3	Resolution approving two emergency public work contracts of the San Francisco	
4	Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) under San Francisco Administrative Code Section	
5	6.60, to replace the unstable roofs on six digesters and two biosolids storage cake bins	
6	at the Southeast Water Pollution Control Plant at 750 Phelps Street with a contract	
7	amount not to exceed \$10,335,427.	
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9	WHEREAS, On November 26, 2012 and March 5, 2013, the SFPUC Wastewater	
10	Enterprise (WWE) requested two separate emergencies be declared to replace the unstable	
11	roofs first on one digester and subsequently on five additional digesters and two biosolids	
12	storage cake bins at the Southeast Water Pollution Control Plant (SEP) at 750 Phelps Street	
13	San Francisco, CA due to the extremely deteriorating condition of the existing aged biosoilds	
14	treatment and handling facilities; and	
15	WHEREAS, If the unstable roofs on the six digesters and two biosolids cake bins are	
16	not replaced and expeditiously returned to service, the result may lead to the failure of key	
17	treatment processes of which the SEP handles for 80% of the City, as well as the severe risk	
18	to permit compliance, health and safety of plant personnel, and significant impacts to the	
19	neighboring residential community, which would endanger the public's health and welfare; and	
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1	WHEREAS, San Francisco Administrative Code, Chapter 6, Article IV, Section 6.60,
2	authorizes department heads responsible for public work to award an emergency contract,
3	exempt from the competitive bidding process, in the event of an actual emergency which is
4	to include, " The breakdown or imminent breakdown of any plant, equipment, structure,
5 6	street or public work necessitating immediate emergency repair or reconditioning to safeguard
7	the lives or property of the citizens, or the property of the City and County, or to maintain the
8	public health and welfare"; and
9	WHEREAS, On November 27, 2012 and March 11, 2013, the SFPUC General
10	Manager declared two separate emergencies, approved by the President of the San
11	Francisco Public Utilities Commission, to replace the unstable roofs on first one digester and
12	subsequently five additional digesters and two biosolids storage cake bins at the SEP and
13 14	thereby protect public health and safety; and
15	WHEREAS, Administrative Code Section 6.60(D) requires that the General Manager
16	immediately notify the Controller, and seek Board of Supervisors approval of emergency
17	public works with an estimated cost in excess of \$250,000; and
18	WHEREAS, The SFPUC General Manager estimates that the emergency work to
19	replace the unstable roofs on six digesters and two biosolids storage cake bins at the SEP will
20	cost approximately \$10,335,427; and
21 22	WHEREAS, The Controller defined has certified that funds are available for this
22	emergency work and contract; now, therefore, be it
24	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the emergency work under
25	Administrative Code Section 6.60, for the replacement of the unsound roofs on six digesters
