Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. This section is uncodified.

This ordinance hereby ratifies the acceptance of all prior private gifts and grants of cash, goods, or services, including in-kind goods or services, received by the San Francisco Public Library.

Section 2. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 10.100-87 to read as follows:

## SEC. 10.100-87. LIBRARY GIFT FUND.

- (a) Establishment of Fund. The Library Gift Fund is established as a category eight fund to receive all private gifts up to \$100,000 of cash, goods, or services, including in-kind goods or services, which-may be offered to the City and County of San Francisco to support San Francisco Public Library programs, facilities, and operations.
- (b) Use of Fund. The fund is to be used exclusively for the purposes of supporting San

  Francisco Public Library programs, facilities, and operations, including but not limited to music-based children's literacy programs, services for the Blind & Print Disabled, and workshops for students.
  - (c) Administration of Fund. The Library will be the administering department for this fund.

## LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

(Amended in Committee on 6/21/13)

[Administrative Code - Library Gift Fund]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to create a San Francisco Public Library gift fund.

## **Existing Law**

Currently, the Library does not have a special gift fund. The Library may accept and expend gifts worth up to \$10,000. The Library may not accept and expend gifts worth over \$10,000 without approval from the Board of Supervisors.

### Amendments to Current Law

The proposed amendment would establish a category eight fund for purposes of supporting Library programs, facilities, and operations. Using this fund, the Library could accept and expends gifts worth up to \$100,000. Gifts worth over \$100,000 would still require Board of Supervisors approval.

On June 21, 2013, the Board of Supervisors Budget and Finance Committee amended the legislation to (1) add the \$100,000 limit, and (2) delete in its entirety Section 3 of the proposed amendment that would have amended the grant procedures for the Library.

## **OTHER RELATED LEGISLATION**

<u>File 13-0544:</u> The proposed ordinance amends the Administrative Code to (1) create a San Francisco Public Library gift fund; and (2) amend the procedures to accept and expend grants.

Currently, the Library does not have a gift fund to receive private gifts of cash, goods, or services. The proposed ordinance would create a gift fund to receive these private gifts, including in-kind goods or services, as a category eight fund, allowing appropriation of fund revenues without further Board of Supervisors approval.

The Budget and Legislative Analyst recommends amending the proposed ordinance to require Board of Supervisors approval by resolution of donations of a cash or market value greater than \$100,000.

The proposed ordinance would exclude grants from non-profit organizations to the Library to support the Library's activities from the existing Administrative Code provision requiring Board of Supervisors approval by resolution of the acceptance and expenditure of grants of \$100,000 or more. Under the proposed ordinance, the Controller would prescribe the rules for the acceptance and expenditure of such funds.

The Budget and Legislative Analyst recommends amending the proposed ordinance to delete this provision. Under the Budget and Legislative Analyst's recommendation, grants from non-profit organizations of \$100,000 or more would continue to require Board of Supervisors approval by resolution.

#### Recommendations:

Amend the proposed ordinance to (1) require Board of Supervisors approval by resolution of donations of a cash or market value of \$100,000 or more; and (2) delete the provision excluding grants to the Library from non-profit organizations from the requirement that the Board of Supervisors approve by resolution the acceptance and expenditure of grants of \$100,000 or more.
