Premise to premise transfer, to be able to license the front entrance of our store which is currently not licensed yet to serve alcoholic beverage. The address of the premise is 810 mission street, and will remain at the same address. The main part of the store is already licensed to sell alcoholic beverages and only the entrance is not, due to how the original transfer from the previous owner was a person to person transfer and the new entrance came after the person to person transfer.

Our business hours are, Monday to Thursday 7am to 12am, Friday from 7am to 2am, Saturday from 9am to 2am and Sunday from 9am to 12am

This business has been in our family and in this location for over 20 years. We are an important part of the neighborhood as many group of people count on us throughout the day, from morning student buying coffee, office workers getting their lunch and energy drink at our deli to tourists and visitors looking to buy a bottle of wine from Napa valley or a nice bottle of scotch to share with friends. Our business hours make it very reliable for our customers in need, very early in the morning or late at night, to get their needs, without having to go miles away.

Granting our licensing of the front entrance of the store will allow us to extend our selection of beverages and good to our customers and it will make the store look complete and full, and customers will have the feeling that they will be able to find what they are looking for. We are a small business dedicated to carry the largest selection possible of popular beverages as well as rare and hard to find one. Giving us the space to display and sale our product will contribute as well to the businesses around us, like hotels as they can send their guest to us to find what they are looking for.

Contrary to big chain store that buy in large quantity, therefore can only buy large production items, we can serve the city as we carry very small production beverages that only a family run store can carry as we get those beverages bottle at a time. We currently have a lot of customers coming to our store from different part of town just because we carry items that no one else carries and those customers count on us as well as spread the word around about their finds.
