Motion amending the Board's Rules of Order to add Rule 2.32, requiring each candidate for a Board, Commission or advisory body appointment or confirmation who would be required to file a Form 700 (Statement of Economic Interests) to submit such a Statement to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors prior to Board Consideration of the appointment or confirmation, and allowing the Board to consider appointments or confirmations, despite the failure of an applicant to file a completed Form 700, if the time for Board consideration is about to expire.

MOVED, That Rule 2.32 is hereby added to the Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors, to read as follows:

RULE 2.32. CERTAIN CANDIDATES FOR COMMISSION APPOINTMENTS MUST SUBMIT A FORM 700 PRIOR TO BOARD CONSIDERATION. Neither the Board of Supervisors, nor any Committee thereof, except as provided below, shall consider the appointment or confirmation of any person whose appointment to a Board, Commission or advisory body is subject to approval or confirmation by the Board of Supervisors, until the person has submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completed Statement of Economic Interests ("Form 700"), if the Form would be required under the California Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 87100, et seq., and San Francisco Campaign and Government Conduct Code Section 3.1.-100, et seq., for the office sought. If the Clerk of the Board determines that an applicant for an appointment may not submit a completed Form 700 in

time to allow the Board to consider the appointment prior to the appointment becoming final by
