designate, by motion, an appropriate committee of the Board to act as a "Committee on Parades" for the purposes set forth in the Police Code. An applicant for a parade permit under the Police Code may appeal the denial of an application for a parade permit, or the imposition of conditions on the issuance of a permit, to the Committee on Parades, if such appeal can be timely made. The Committee shall consider such appeal and may either concur in the action of the Chief of Police, or overrule such action and order that the permit be approved. If the Committee orders that a permit be approved, it shall have the authority to impose only such conditions as are recommended by the Chief of Police. The Board of Supervisors has not yet designated a Committee on Parades, as required by the Police Code.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby designates the City Operations and Neighborhood Services Committee of the Board of Supervisors as the Committee on Parades, as required by Police Code Section 371.
