11 that its designation as a Landmark will further the purposes of,
12 and conform to the standards set forth in Article 10 of the City
13 Planning Code.

(a) <u>Designation</u>: Pursuant to Section 1004 of the Planning Code, Chapter II, Part II of the San Francisco Municipal Code, 573-575 Castro Street, the Castro Camera and Harvey Milk Residence, is hereby designated as Landmark No. 227. This designation has been fully approved by Resolution No. 14492of the Planning Commission, which Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors under File No. <u>000529</u> and which Resolution is incorporated herein and made part hereof as though fully set forth.
